

## Project Background

The City of Marysville, in partnership with Snohomish County, has constructed Phase I and II of the Bayview Trail from State Route 528 to 84<sup>th</sup> St. NE. The City, with support from the County, is ready to move forward with Phase III in order to construct the remaining one-mile of paved asphalt trail from 84<sup>th</sup> St. NE north to interest and connect to the regional Centennial Trail system.

## Improvements

The Centennial Trail Connector via Bayview Trail project will extend the recently constructed Bayview Trail within Marysville, Washington to connect to the regional Centennial Trail located throughout Snohomish County. The project will construct approximately one-mile of paved asphalt trail from the existing terminus of the Bayview Trail at 84<sup>th</sup> St. NE, extending north to intersect with the regional Centennial Trail system. The project will link users, by providing alternative modes of transportation, to regional employment, commercial/residential centers and recreation throughout the region. The project will include the design, right-of-way or easement acquisition and construction. The City of Marysville and Snohomish County are currently working together on the viable project.

In 2016, the City purchased a key property required to make the connection to Centennial Trail. The City and County are partnering together to fund up to 50-percent of the project with the intent of the remaining match coming from other sources.
