Even though they are called a trout, bull trout are actually a char. They are closely related to lake trout and brook trout rather than rainbow or cutthroat trout.

Bull trout have different life histories that can vary by individual population. Some spend their entire lives in small streams and their size remains small. Some migrate from small streams to larger rivers and back again to the stream to spawn. Those fish are generally larger.
